A Contract with Nevada

## Outlining Jeff Stone's Legislative Priorities

- 1. Election Integrity** — The integrity of our election process is important to all Nevadans. Nevadans deserve to know their votes are counted fairly and accurately and are not subjected to outside attacks and interferences. As your legislator, I will champion and support legislation that:
  - a. Requires Photo Identification for All Voters
  - b. Abolishes Ballot Harvesting
  - c. Abolishes Automatic Motor-Voter Registration
  - d. Requires Citizenship Status on All Nevada Driver's Licenses and state issued ID cards
  - e. Increases Criminal Penalties for Aiding and Abetting Voter Fraud
  - f. Grants any Nevada voter legal standing to sue a person or entity they believe has committed voter fraud.
  - g. Institutes a "loser pays" policy for legal fees on all lawsuits involving voter fraud to prevent frivolous lawsuits
  
- 2. Education** — Efforts from the far left to block parents involvement in their children's education is unacceptable. It is vital for parents to remain in the driver's seat concerning decisions impacting their children's education. Parents and students deserve choice. We must continue to support reforms which emphasize the basics of reading, writing, arithmetic, and raising our low national ranking. As your legislator, I will champion and support legislation that:
  - a. Expands School Choice
  - b. Expands School Voucher Programs
  - c. Bans Critical Race Theory
  - d. Bans Gender Identity Curricula
  
- 3. Economic Development** — In order for Nevada to have a strong and thriving economy, we need to continually strive to keep taxes low and eliminate regulations that disincentivize and stifle economic growth. We have a unique opportunity to make Nevada the most business-friendly state in the Union if we create a more business-friendly environment and tax climate that encourages economic growth. As your legislator, I will OPPOSE all new taxes and will champion and support new legislation that:
  - a. Diversifies Nevada's Economic Base
  - b. Creates a Friendly Business Climate
  - c. Removes "Red Tape" Regulations Limiting Growth and Opportunity
  - d. Protects All Nevada Businesses, Not Just Large Corporations
  - e. Addresses Infrastructure and Water Needs

**4. Healthcare** — As a healthcare professional, I know that healthcare providers are trained to listen to patients and fully understand the problem before taking action. The legislature needs to take the same approach when considering legislation that will directly impact our healthcare. We need to create a climate that encourages doctors, nurses and other providers to stay and build their practices right here in Nevada. Our state currently ranks near the bottom in nearly every healthcare metric. I know we can do better. We must change how we address these issues and start providing the care and resources our society needs, and deserves. As your state legislator, I will champion and support legislation that:

- a. Encourages Healthcare Professionals to Stay and Work in Nevada
- b. Abolishes the “Public Option”
- c. Prioritizes Senior Benefits
- d. Addresses Mental Health Needs
- e. Provides Better Access to Healthcare, including Rural Nevada
- f. Lowers Costs for Patients and Providers
- g. Maintains Voter Passed “Keep Our Doctors In Nevada” Initiative

**5. State Government** — Examining and consolidating state agencies is vital to minimizing the duplication of effort and reducing the size and scope of government overreach. As a result, our efforts will streamline cost-effective government services for all Nevadans. We must always look to eliminate wasteful spending and limit the government’s control of our daily lives. As your state legislator, I will champion and support legislation that:

- a. Limits Executive Powers of The Governor to 60 Days Unless Voted On and Approved by the Nevada State Legislature
- b. Consolidates Government Agencies and Departments Where Appropriate
- c. Supports EWIN (Eliminate Waste in Nevada)
- d. Revamps and Streamlines the Department of Motor Vehicles
- e. Increases Services to Rural Communities
- f. Eliminates Wasteful and Unnecessary Spending

**6. Public Safety** — Public Safety will always remain a top priority of mine for Nevada. The “Defund the Police” movement will have no home in the Silver State. Day after day, our first responders risk their lives to keep our communities safe and secure. We must do everything in our power to ensure that they are adequately funded and receive the highest levels of training available. As your state legislator, I will stand by those who keep us safe and will champion and support legislation that:

- a. Maintains public safety as a top priority
- b. Adequately Funds the Police
- c. Equips First Responders with the most effective equipment and training available
- d. Outlaws Sanctuary Cities in Nevada
- e. Withholds state funds from any Nevada city that makes such a declaration by ordinance or proclamation
